The design offers complete freedom of movement for agile work using manual tools. The belt has an integrated 0.74 gal hydration system and features the Molle System which helps arrange the accessories each user needs.

Waterproof and highly resistant to abrasion, cuts and tears

Made with ¹1000 Cordura and breathable mesh². It features heat-sealed zippers to ensure tightness in wet environments³.

Belt-integrated hydration system

Includes the Hydrapack[®] system⁴ with a tube and nozzle tip⁵ on the outside and 0.74 gal capacity with an upper opening for easy fill and cleaning. FDA-approved tank, PVC and BPA-free.
